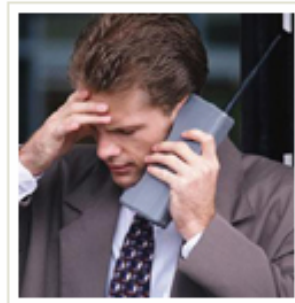


Voicemail to email in minutes with SimulScribe
